FUTURE AIRSPACE STRATEGY VFR IMPLEMENTATION GROUP

As part of the Future Airspace Strategy, the NATMAC Class G Working Group analysed the variety of activities taking place in Class G Airspace leading to a paper on Class G for the 21st Century and in July 2013 a Class G airspace conference debated the issues. To take this forward for the non-commercial and military aviation segments it has been decided to set up a group which would look to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of VFR operations in the UKFIR, mirroring the work of the FASIIG and using similar structures and processes. Led by the VFR users, the aim would be "to provide a sustainable future for VFR operations within FAS".

The initial meeting of stakeholders for this FAS VFR Implementation Group (FASVIG) will be held at the CAA London on 17 January 2013 and we envisage that this would lead to a 2 year programme chaired initially by John Brady, vice-chairman of the LAA. I attach a draft agenda. This work will be of greatest concern to organisations which have a particular interest in VFR operations but it could have an impact on other stakeholders too so you may wish to participate or perhaps just be included in the distribution of documents.
